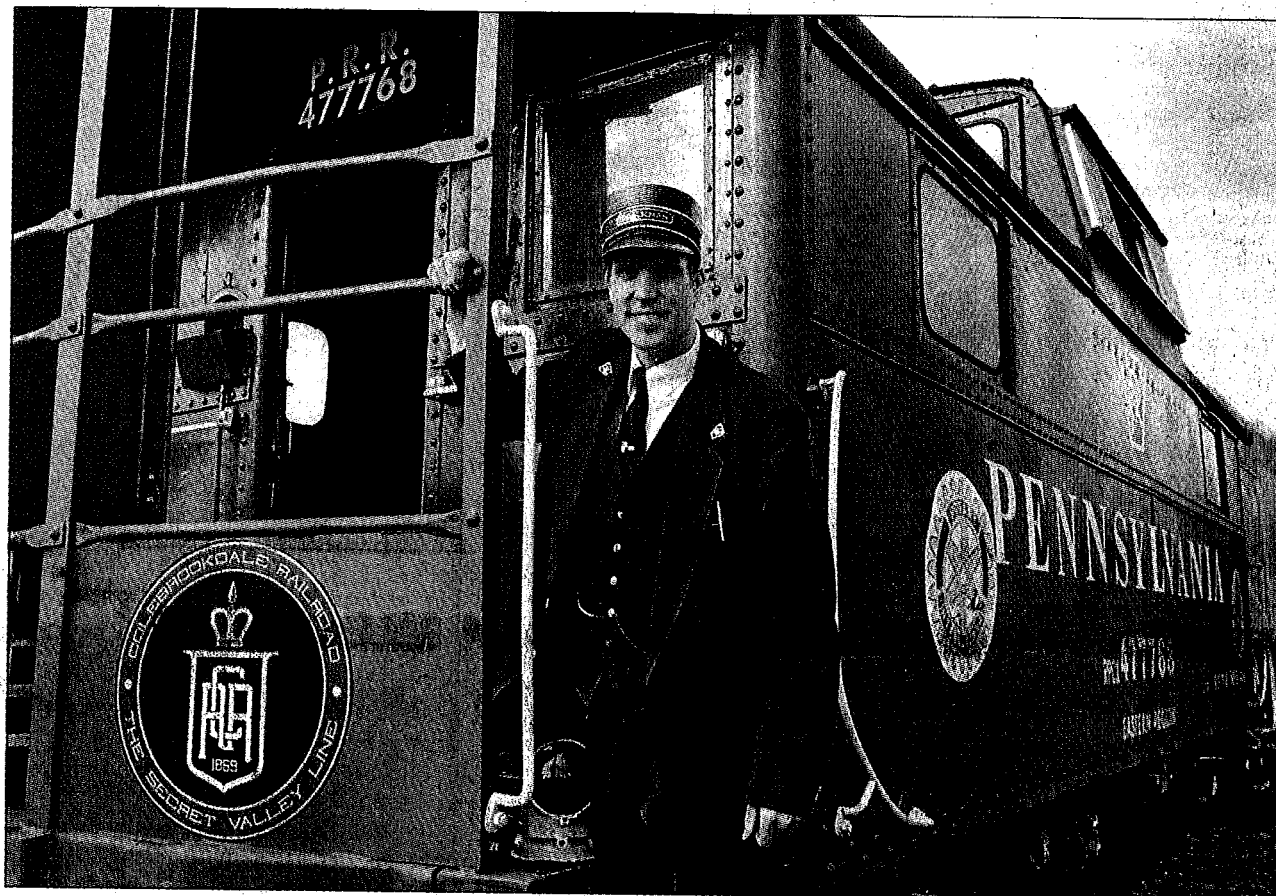


Rail-time travel



Colebrookdale Railroad Preservation Trust launches trips between Pottstown and Boyertown

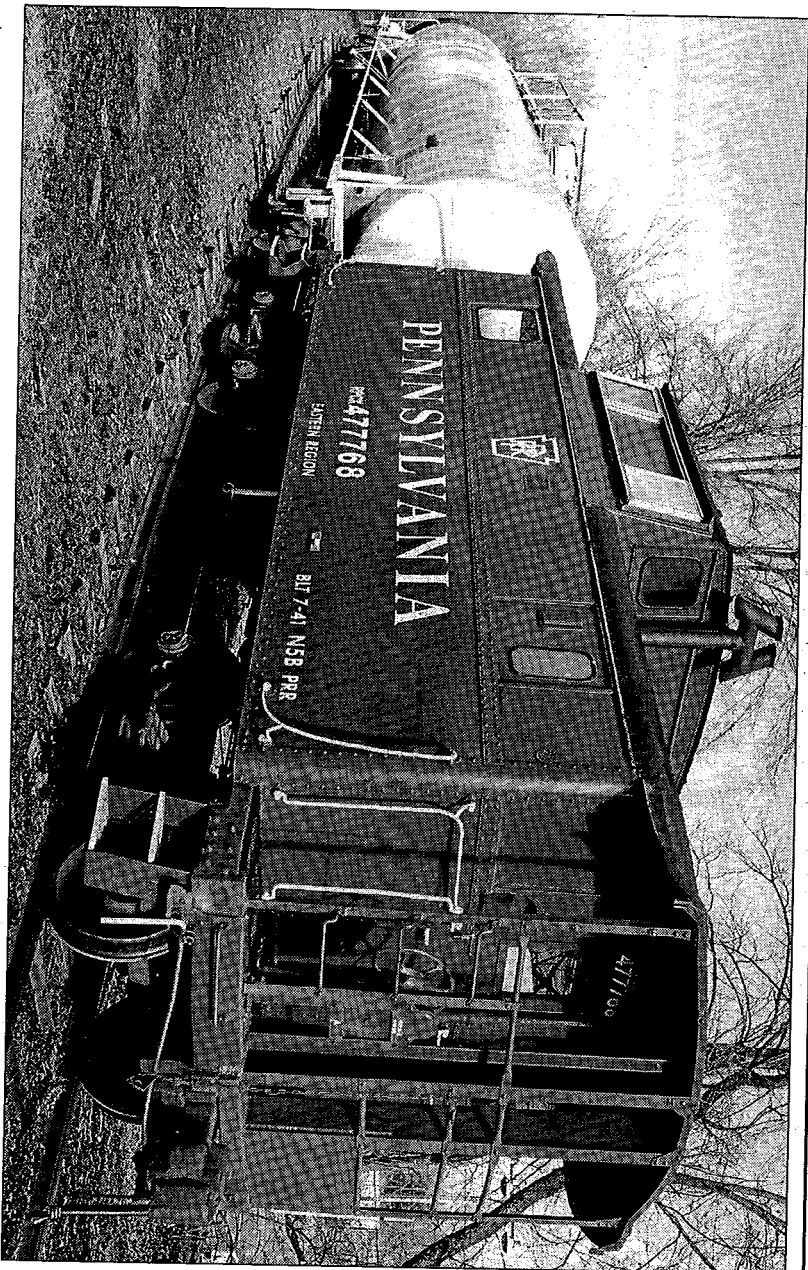
