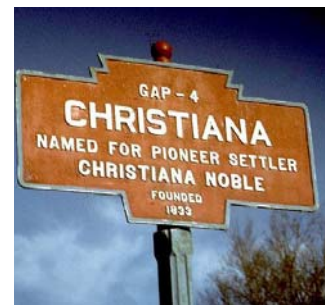




AUTHORIZED MARKER REPAIR FACILITIES

The following organizations have identified themselves as capable of repairing the cast iron Keystone Markers. Please contact the Keystone Marker Trust if you have a marker to repair and we will work with you and the shop of your choice below to establish the best course of repair for your marker. Almost any marker can be repaired, even if it means re-fabricating half of a missing sign! The Loysville sign, shown below, required a significant portion to be fabricated in fiberglass and affixed to the remaining cast iron section. Missing letters can be CNC machined and applied. We do not recommend any repairs that would mar the face of the sign; if bracing is to be added, it should be done on the reverse of the marker as inconspicuously as possible.
